

# Chaplain's Words of Wisdom

**Father Anton's words of wisdom:** Time seems to be going by so quickly these days; we've



ended the Christmas season today with the feast of the Presentation of our Lord in the temple, and we are already into the third week of our pre-Lenten readings. The calling of Zacchaeus reminds us that if we truly accept the invitation of Christ, our eyes can be opened, our hearts softened and our lives transformed. We will practice righteousness instead of self-righteousness, and no longer compare ourselves to others or think ourselves better or more superior than another. The Gospel story of the Publican and the Pharisee teaches us about true humility and the true spirit of prayer. We don't pray to God because He needs us, but rather because we need Him! True prayer

always begins in and attitude of humility and faith. We acknowledge before God our limitations and weaknesses and He gives us in return blessings and forgiveness – in this way we have a genuine relationship, no pretending to be something we are not. The third Sunday presents us with the story of the Prodigal Son, someone with whom we can all relate. The most important part of this story for us to meditate on is when the Son is ready to come home – off he comes in the distance, practising a script he had prepared hoping his pleading would restore him to his father – but the father sees him in the distance and doesn't wait for him to come before him and grovel at his feet, rather he goes to meet him and seeing his sorrow and confusion embraces him and welcomes him home. That is how it is for you and me. God simply seeks the contrite heart, he doesn't expect us to BEG for forgiveness, but rejoiced when we are able to be honest with ourselves and the life we are living – our darkness turning to light once more – we fell our loving Father's embrace. The last two readings are about fasting, Cheesefare, and Meatfare. We are told in what spirit we are to fast and sacrifice. We are not to go around bragging, nor are we to criticize someone who is not fasting. Remember, with God everything is about invitation. We are free to accept the invitation or reject it but are not free of it's consequences. I often wonder what kind of sacrifice it is in our modern day to fast from meat... lobster, crab legs, shrimp, scallops... not really a sacrifice to my mind. The idea is self discipline...we can go to Mass, fast on Fridays and during Lent and be the worst example of a Christian possible... gossip, lying to get ahead, putting other down etc. Obviously, these actions negate and of the good fasting is to bring about. The true Christian, accepting God's invitation does everything with joy, does not puff themselves up, is kind to others, non-judgemental and has a healthy relationship with God because they interact with Him daily through prayer. As Lent approaches my prayer for you is that you journey deep into your inner dessert and spend time daily with Christ. Lay bear everything that sits heavy on your heart, share you fears, your doubt and disappoints, but also share you joy, your trials and triumphs...you'll be surprised how this will change your perspective of life, faith and Church – the Jesus experience can never be taken away – it is something that is yours to treasure always.
