Lecturer's Words of Wisdom

FATHER ANTON'S WORDS OF WISDOM: Well, here we are...another New Year! It is a good time to look back and count our many blessings in 2021. While that Pandemic was and is still with us, we still have so much to be thankful for. I hear so many complaints about how difficult life has been, but it really is a matter of perspective:

"Imagine you were born in 1900. On your 14th birthday, World War I starts, and ends on your 18th birthday. 22 million people perish in that war. Later in the year, a Spanish Flu epidemic hits the planet and runs until your 20th birthday. 50 million people die from it in those two years. Yes, 50 million. On your 29th birthday, the Great Depression begins. Unemployment hits 25%, the World GDP drops 27%. That runs until you are 33. The country nearly collapses along with the world economy. When you turn 39, World War II starts. You aren't even over the hill yet. And don't try to catch your breath. On your 41st birthday, the United States is fully pulled into WWII. Between your 39th and 45th birthday, 75 million people perish in the war. At 50, the Korean War starts. 5 million perish. At 55 the Vietnam War begins and doesn't end for 20 years. 4 million people perish in that conflict. On your 62nd birthday you have the Cuban Missile Crisis, a tipping point in the Cold War. Life on our planet, as we know it, should have ended. Great leaders prevented that from happening. When you turn 75, the Vietnam War finally ends. Think of everyone on the planet born in 1900. How do you survive all of that? When you were a kid in 1985 and didn't think your 85 year old grandparent understood how hard school was. And how mean that kid in your class was. Yet they survived through everything listed above. Perspective is an amazing art, refined as time goes on, and enlightening like you wouldn't believe. Let's try and keep things in perspective."

Just think how difficult life was for your grandparents and parents, and how little they complained. They placed their trust in God and His providence, and throughout all these difficult times, still managed to laugh and enjoy life. They embraced this country and respected authority.

Unfortunately we have a generation or two who grew up without experiencing a lot of hardships and as a result society is becoming more and more about “me” with little regard to others.

So many comments on how few people have died of Corona Virus without realizing that this is only because Public Health Authorities have been pro-active. The safety measures and precautions put into place have saved countless lives. The concern now is with regard to the health system being overburdened beyond capacity, so new measures have to be put into place. We are being asked to get vaccinated not just to protect ourselves, but those in our society who are most vulnerable. You cannot claim to be pro-life and at the same time deny the dignity and value of the lives of ALL in society.

I truly believe that we are close to the end of this Pandemic, and soon life we return back to the way we knew, but I am not sure that this is best thing....Why? Because I hope that we have learned to care about our neighbour as Jesus asks in the Gospel. I hope we have learned more patience, compassion and understanding. I hope that we have learned that there is more to life the material possessions. I hope we have learned that to give up a vacation is not the end of the world; we will be able to take them again when it is safe. I hope we have learned that we are all God’s children and as such need to assist one another and, if that means wearing a mask, social distancing, going out only when necessary or getting a vaccine, then we are not being asked to do a whole lot. Bodies aren’t piling up like they did with the Spanish Flu, we are not at war, with bombs falling all around us, we may be in a recession but it is nothing like the Great Depression. Our medical care is equal to all our citizens, our health professionals are worked to the point of exhaustion, and no one is trying to control us with some kind of hidden agenda.

Yes we have much to thank God for this past year, and much to look forward to in the year ahead. Keep your eyes fixed on Jesus and you will experience His loving presence in every situation: In the Doctor telling you how to keep safe. In the nurse, overworked and, still volunteering to help with vaccines. In our governing officials trying their best to navigate the waters of this Pandemic and although at times may seem a bit overbearing, have the best interest of you and I at heart. We may not always agree, but we have the ability to be respectful of one another, and setting aside personal opinion for the safety of others.

May you look back on 2021 and be grateful, may you look forward in 2022 with hope and your eyes fixed on our Lord, then there will be nothing we cannot handle with His help. God bless all of you, get your vaccine, get boosted, wear your masks, social distance and stay safe.

May the blessing of the Lord be upon you, through the grace and loving kindness of His only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, with Whom He is blessed, now, always and forever. Amen.
