Chaplain's Words of Wisdom

FATHER ANTON'S WORDS OF WISDOM: Well, another Christmas has come and gone, and we celebrate



a New Year. It's interesting that we forget that; although we set aside December 25th each year to celebrate the birth of Christ, we forget the "God is with us! / Z Nami Boh" every moment of every day. As we welcome and celebrate a New Year let's try to be more conscious of the presence of Jesus in our everyday lives. As we awake a simple prayer is enough, something like: "Thank you Jesus for another day. Help me to remember that there is nothing that I cannot deal with so long as you are with me." We celebrate in our tradition on January 1st the Circumcision of our Lord... the cutting away of the old that we might be made anew. New Year's is often a time of reflection. We think back on the events of our life, some make us smile, some make us laugh, some make us cry and others remind us of what it means to be human. If you were to drive your car looking only in the rear-view mirror, you certainly wouldn't get anywhere, and sooner or later crash. It is the same with our lives, looking and living in the past does not allow us to grow and move on. Learning to let go may not be easy but is so necessary if we are to move forward. The past is where we learned the lesson, the present is where we apply it. Jesus reminds us also that to have peace we need to learn to live one day at a time. We do not know what tomorrow may bring, and we cannot change the past, the present is where we have every opportunity to shine. The world is in turmoil, and it doesn't look

like things are going to change anytime soon, but the way we choose to respond will have a huge impact on our daily lives. Lent is just around the corner... a time to take an inward journey. Why not start it a bit early, escape somewhere to the quiet everyday and just "be". In the quiet simply reflect on life, what is happening in your own life and those around you. What is happening in our world. Ask yourself "how do I respond?" How is your one-on-one relationship with Jesus. How is your prayer life. How healthy is your faith... these are heavy questions, but when dealt with in the presence of our Saviour can bring us much insight, spiritual growth and peace.

May this New Year bring all of you a stronger faith, healing where it is needed, peace in times of turmoil, good health and the reassurance that you are indeed a child of God and that he love you deeply.
