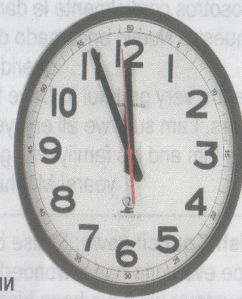
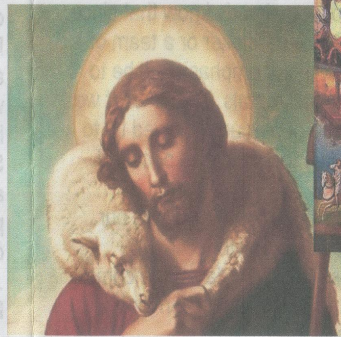

I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday and enjoyed the long hot summer we have been blessed with. Hopefully, the heat we endured during Mass is behind us.

The severance and sale of the property is moving ahead, with the buyer dealing with a number of issues before the city grants

the necessary approvals. We are still hopeful for a November closing.

In our negotiations with the Eparchy to obtain their approval for the severance and sale of the land, we made a commitment to them to remain financially healthy after the sale. This was going to be accomplished by having the hall available for rental as much as possible 7 days a week. We approached Dave Paulino with the changes that the church needed. After discussions with Dave, he was unable to commit to the needs of the church, which included, 1. Maintaining a Website for our hall rentals and 2. Making it available for rentals, 7 days week as well as the regular maintenance. Dave's last day was August 31. Church Council has made an agreement with a group led by Jose Velilla and Zach Lopatniuk, members of the YOUNG MENS BIBLE STUDY GROUP to take on the new requirements our council has outlined.
