We are still in the midst of Russia's war of our beloved Ukraine, and like my brother Knights, my parish of St. John's has been working tirelessly to raise funds needed for medical, food, and humanitarian aid, as well as to help with the cost of shipping. Through all of this turmoil, and the many natural disasters occurring throughout the world and the forest fires here in Canada, it at times, is almost to much to make sense of.
